New Business

Relief Committee - Veteran Support Motions (Tony Newton)

- Emergency Action Funding Request #1
 - Discussion: John has confirmed through Lost Vets rescue that these veterans are in valid need of support. The goal, is to get them off the street for the next week and bridge the gap until further support from Lost vets is available (see below). My understanding is that they have the location of one veteran and they are trying to locate the other. Estimated hotel cost is 91.49 per night. The emergency action request is to provide the cost of a hotel for up to 10 days for each veteran to ensure we cover the gap. The request is for the EXCOM to approve the expenditure of up to \$1000.00 for each veteran to pay for up to 10 nights of hotel accommodations for a total of \$2000.00. It is understood that the second \$1000.00 would not be expended until the second veteran is located by Lost Vets
 - Motion; That, in support of the veteran in need, Tellico Village VFW Post 12135 approves the EXCOMs emergency action decision for the release of funds NTE \$1000 per veteran (\$2000 total), with the second veteran's funds for \$1000 to be held until Lost Vets relocates him.
 - The motion was seconded by James Stutz. After a general discussion, the motion was passed unanimously without further discussion or dissent.
- Emergency Action Funding Request #2
 - Discussion: Relief committee was contacted to assist a veteran who needed help with his rent, two months at 402 for a total of 804 and past due phone bill of 106.79.
 The need was verified by the relief committee as valid and meeting the intent of the posts policy on providing support.
 - Motion; That, in support of the veteran in need, Tellico Village VFW Post 12135 authorize funds in the amount of \$804 for two months rent and \$106.79 for the past due phone bill. Phone bill funding is to reimburse John Lacko.
 - After a general discussion, the motion was amended to waive the "One and Done" policy in case the veteran is in further need of continued support until benefits have been processed.
 - The motion was seconded by David Crowden and passed unanimously without further discussion or dissent.
